and adherence to environmental guidelines.

3. Construction and Demolition Companies

Companies involved in large-scale construction or demolition projects must comply with waste segregation and disposal norms, requiring an SWM certificate.

4. Bulk Consumers and Commercial Establishments

Hospitals, hotels, malls, restaurants, and large commercial facilities generating significant solid waste must apply for certification to manage waste responsibly.

5. Waste Management and Recycling Companies

Companies engaged in collection, transportation, processing, or recycling of solid waste must obtain SWM certification to operate legally and maintain environmental standards.

Application Process for Solid Waste Management Certificate

Register with SPCB/CPCB Portal – Complete online registration for waste management operations.

Submit Required Documents – Include business registration, waste generation and handling details, treatment plans, and environmental compliance records.

Inspection – Authorities conduct an inspection to verify adherence to SWM rules.

Approval and Certification – After satisfactory compliance, the SWM certificate is issued.

Renewal – Certificates are generally valid for a specified period and must be renewed before expiry.
